# Day 1: Thursday, November 20 – Home – Le Centre Sheraton Hotel, Montreal, OC

• Enjoy quiet time early morning on the motor coach and arrive at Montreal late afternoon. As a reminder, our motor coach is equipped with WIFI, and each seat is equipped with a power source for your personal electronics and convenience.

  - We will be making early pick-ups this morning with rest-stops along the way.
  - We will make rest stops and a stop for breakfast, then, we'll continue onto Quebec. Don't forget to set your watches back one hour as we cross the Provincial Border into Quebec!
  - Relax for the remainder of the trip as we travel past Quebec City and Drummondville before heading into historic downtown Montreal! Our coach will have a rest stop between Quebec and Montreal where you can use restrooms, grab a coffee, and other essentials all in one stop.

- Upon arrival at the Le Centre Sheraton Hotel, relax while your tour manager checks the group in, distributes the room keys and has your luggage sent to your room. This is just one of the many benefits of our escorted tours!
- Enjoy the rest of the evening and have dinner (on own) with many options nearby all within walking distance.

## Day 2: Friday, November 21 - Le Centre Sheraton Hotel, Montreal, QC

• Enjoy breakfast on your own this morning before joining your fellow travelers and local guide for a 3-hour professionally guided tour of Montreal. This tour will highlight many of the city's most iconic landmarks and cultures. You will have time to visit Mount Royal, Old Montreal, and other areas within the city's limits and learn in-depth history and culture of Montreal, from one of the locals.



- Our hotel is conveniently located within walking distance of Saint Catherine Street, Crescent Street, Bishop Street & the Bell Centre.
- The rest of the afternoon and evening are free for you to enjoy your way.

# Day 3: Saturday, November 22 – Le Centre Sheraton Hotel – Bell Centre GAME DAY: Toronto Maple Leafs vs. Montreal Canadiens

- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are on your own today. Enjoy the morning and afternoon your way and get ready for the exciting game ahead this evening!
- Prior to Game Day, you will be provided your electronic ticket through the Ticketmaster app to enter the Bell Centre with your seat location provided. Depart the hotel for the Bell Centre, just one block away, giving you plenty of time to enjoy the pre-game vibe at the Bell Centre before the official 7:00pm start of the action as the Montreal Canadiens faces off against their long-time rivals, the Toronto Maple Leafs. Please have your electronic tickets uploaded into your Apple or Google wallet or equivalent and be ready to show it to the Bell Centre Attendants for access at the entrance. Kindly note, motorcoach transportation to the Bell Centre and pick up will be available for those who wish to have it.
- Following the game, you have the remainder of the evening to enjoy at your leisure and make your own way back to the hotel. Transportation will be provided for those who wish to return to the hotel by bus following the game. You will have only 20 minutes after the game ends to make your way back to the bus, otherwise, we will assume you are returning by foot. If you know in advance you are walking back to the hotel (only 5 min walk) please inform your tour manager.
- Enjoy what Montreal has to offer on a Saturday night. Remember it's an early departure tomorrow morning.

## Day 4: Sunday, November 23 - Home

- Rise and Shine! Enjoy breakfast on your own this morning.
- We depart the hotel early morning so passengers can board the coach in a timely manner. Don't worry, there will be plenty of time to relax and rest on the bus on our way back to the Maritimes.
- Our first stop today will be a mid morning coffee break (25 min), followed by a 45 min lunch stop (your expense). We will also stop for a later afternoon coffee break (20 min) before the final

- stretch of our journey. Once again, don't forget to adjust your watches ahead 1 hour when we cross the Provincial border and enter New Brunswick.
- All passengers will be transferred back to their original locations at the estimated arrival times listed below. All times are estimates as traffic, weather, and unexpected circumstances may cause delayed arrival or departure times
