Day 1: Thursday, July 23 – Home – Sheraton Boston Hotel, Boston, MA

- Enjoy quiet time early morning on the motor coach and arrive in Boston late afternoon. As a reminder, our motor coach is equipped with WIFI (within Canada), and each seat is equipped with a power source for your personal electronics and convenience.

PEI:

- Royalty Crossing, near Super Store Entrance
– 4:45AM (Shuttle to Aulac)

New Brunswick:

- Aulac Irving Big Stop – 6:25AM – 6:45AM (20-minute rest stop to collect PEI passengers)
- Moncton, Magneti Hill McDonalds – 7:25AM
- Saint John, Route 1 Irving – 8:50AM
- Lincoln Big Stop – 10:00AM-10:45AM (45 minutes breakfast stop)

- We will be making early pick-ups this morning with rest-stops along the way.
- We will make rest stops and a stop for breakfast, then, we'll continue onto Boston. Don't forget to set your watches back one hour as we cross the Border into Maine!
- We will make a stop for lunch along our route today (your expense).
- Relax for the remainder of the trip as we travel through Maine and head into the historic downtown district of Boston! Our coach will have rest stops between Calais and Boston where you can use restrooms, grab a coffee, or any other essentials.

- Get ready for the First Game of the tour at Fenway Park! Meet your tour manager and fellow travellers to be transported by motorcoach from the hotel to Fenway Park.



- The action starts at 7:10pm! Kindly note: Motorcoach transportation to Fenway Park and pick up will be available for those who wish to have it. You will have only 20 minutes after the game ends to make your way back to the bus, otherwise, we will assume you are returning by foot. If you know in advance you are walking back to the hotel (about a 15 min walk) please inform your tour manager.
- Following the game, the evening is yours to explore (your expense).

Day 3: Saturday, July 25 – Sheraton Boston Hotel – Fenway Park

- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are on your own today.

purchase some peanuts and crackerjacks! (Kindly note: Motorcoach transportation to Fenway Park and pick up will be available for those who wish to have it. You will have only 20 minutes after the game ends to make your way back to the bus, otherwise, we will assume you are returning by foot. If you know in advance you are walking back to the hotel-about a 15 min walk, please inform your tour manager).

- Following the game, you have the remainder of the night to enjoy at your leisure (your expense). Enjoy what Boston has to offer on a Saturday night but remember it's an early departure tomorrow morning.

Day 4: Sunday, July 26 – Home

- Rise and Shine! Enjoy breakfast on your own this morning. We depart the hotel early morning so passengers can board the coach in a timely manner. Don't worry, there will be plenty of time to relax and rest on the bus on our way back to the Maritimes.
- Our first stop today will be a mid morning coffee break (25 min), followed by a 45 min lunch stop (your expense). We will also stop for a later afternoon coffee break (20 min) before the final stretch of our journey. Once again, don't forget to adjust your watches ahead 1 hour when we cross the border and enter into New Brunswick.
- All passengers will be transferred back to their original locations at the estimated arrival times listed below. All times are estimates as traffic, weather, and unexpected circumstances may cause delayed arrival or departure times

- We ask that everyone respect timelines, as determined by your tour manager, as well as keeping scents to a minimum due to some passenger having allergies. This will help ensure ALL clients are able to enjoy themselves to the fullest.
- **U.S. Customs and Immigration – All people must present a valid passport to enter the country. The U.S. has the right to refuse entry to anyone with a past record.
